III. PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT

Ilian is one of the barangays in Matalam, North Cotabato bounded by barangays Natutungan to the North, Kilada to the South, Marbel to the East, and Sanggadong to the West. It is accessible by land transportation from the highway of Matalam until the barangay road in Marbel. From the barangay road, a two-kilometer cart trail leads to Ilian, cut by the Marbel River which can be crossed only when the water level is low and impassable during rainy season making Ilian virtually isolated.

Ilian has a total land area of 684 hectares. Of this, 110 hectares is planted with rice; 200 hectares with corn, 60 hectares of coconuts and 220 hectares with sugarcane.
